RE: WANGU COMMUNITY UPLIFTMENT PROGRAMME – CRÈCHE BUILDING

This proposal is submitted by We are Durban on behalf of Impendulo. We are very kindly requesting donations toward the completion of an early Childhood Development and Community Centre construction project. Please see the details below as well as a full wish list of items that we require to make this project a success, some might not be in your area of expertise so please feel free to over look those items, but any help will be greatly appreciated.

We are Durban:

We are Durban is a section 21 Company, registered to bring about change by finding organisations that need assistance to reach their full potential. This is achieved by providing a legal and transparent vehicle by which funding, and volunteers, can be managed to deliver sustainable change. All donations made to We are Durban are tax deductible through your section 18A certificate. We are Durban runs the Olive Tree Church Social Justice department who have undertaken to help with this specific community on the North Coast.

Wangu:

Wangu is a rural community situated near the Amatikulu Nature Reserve approximately 100km north of Durban. It has about 4000 residents who are mainly elderly and children. This is a common problem in rural areas as lack of employment opportunities forces the adults to migrate to cities to find work. The majority of the residents are black Zulu-speaking people.

Impendulo:

Impendulo is an organisation based in Wangu, which was formed in 2006. It is made up of people who have a passion for seeing a change in their own community. Most of members of the Impendulo team have post matric education but have amazingly chosen to remain in the community and be the change so desperately needed. The team is well infiltrated into the community doing regular home visits, running a kids programme on Saturdays, and meeting together weekly to discuss how to change Wangu.

They also currently run a pre-school and day-care facility in the community. The facility utilized until recently is one of the old staff accommodation units in the area. The facility did not have ablutions, thus the pupils and teachers need to utilize the neighboring unit's ablutions. The surrounding area was also unsafe for kids, as there are many open electrical wires from illegal connections.

Project Goal:

The land that has been allocated by the local chief to Impendulo will be used to set up various facilities for the community. These will include offices for the Impendulo team, a crèche and a community center. It will create a safe learning environment for the children.

Status Quo:

Through donations from various entities and the involvement of different organizations, the following activities of the building project have been concluded:

- Ground preparation and Platform creation;
- Construction of Raft Foundation;
- Construction of structure, including a roof;
- Internal finishes;
- 2x Jo-Jo tanks for rainwater harvesting and waters supply; and
- Construction of 2 Jungle Gyms.

The building is ready to be utilized and will be used from the start of the third term, which commences on the 17th of July 2018. Due to a lack of ablutions, the teachers and kids will need to utilize the ablutions of a close by Spaza Shop. We are in the process of arranging temporary ablution facilities until a permanent solution can be constructed.

Project Plan:

- Acquire and erect perimeter fence;
- Acquire and construct ventilated improved pit (VIP) latrines;
- Acquire and plant grass and landscaping;
- Acquire and construct shade-net house for vegetable garden; and
- Acquire and construct remainder of roof structure over verandah area.
